Overview

This bill affects continuing education requirements for insurance agents.

Section

- 1 **Minimum education requirements.** Increases the credit for teaching an insurance continuing education course from 1.5 to 3 times the number of hours taught. Changes the number of credits that may be counted for courses sponsored by insurance companies and courses offered electronically.
