## Bill Summary

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**Version:** As Introduced

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**Subject:** Limited English Proficiency Funding

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### Overview

Under current law, a school district receives \$584 per pupil in basic revenue and up to another \$190 per pupil in concentration revenue for every qualifying student who is not proficient in the English language through the limited English Proficiency (LEP) funding program.

In 2003, the Legislature limited the maximum length of funding for any student to not more than five years of funding.

This bill allows a student to remain eligible for funding for up to seven years.

- 1 Pupil of limited English proficiency.** Allows a student who is not proficient in English to qualify for limited English proficiency (LEP) funding for up to seven years.
