Overview

This bill increases the amount counties may spend for Memorial Day observances.

Section

- 1** **Memorial day, appropriation for observance.** Increases the amount a county board may spend for Memorial Day observances from \$2,000 to \$3,500. Effective July 1, 2008 . The amount was last increased in 1984, from \$1,500 to the current amount of \$2,000.
- 2** **Military service organizations for Memorial Day.** Increases, from \$100 to \$300, the amount a county board may appropriate to each post of a recognized military service persons' organization or society to help pay for Memorial Day exercises. Effective July 1, 2008 . The amount was last increased in 1979, from \$50 to the current amount of \$100.
