Overview

This bill involves numbers used to advertise or otherwise designate the specifications of various grades of motor fuel.

Section

- 1** **Use of a number to advertise a grade of gasoline.** Requires that if a number is used to advertise or identify a grade of gasoline, the number not exceed the octane of the gasoline.
- 2 - 15** These technical sections update ASTM specifications of motor fuels for purposes of regulation by the Weights and Measures Division of the Department of Commerce. ASTM specifications are developed by ASTM International, formerly named American Society for Testing and Materials. The references to these ASTM specification designations need occasional updating to match the updated specifications.
