- 7** **Pollution Control Agency.** Amends Laws 2009, ch. 172, article 2, section 4. Increases, by \$300,000, the appropriation for grants to local units of government to implement best management practices to clean up contaminated sediments in storm water ponds and allows the PCA to use a portion of the funds for the development of related best management practices required last session. Increases, by \$200,000, the appropriation for a restoration project in the Lower St. Louis River, and clarifies that the match must be “at least” \$2 nonstate to every \$1 of state money. Eliminates a \$5,000,000 appropriation for groundwater protection activities that had required a plan and legislative approval.
