### Overview

Repeals the Minnesota Sunset Act. The substantive section of the bill is section 7, which repeals Minnesota Statutes, chapter 3D. The other sections in the bill strike cross-references in other laws to the Sunset Act.

#### Section

- 1**      **Membership terms; Indian Affairs Council.** Strikes a reference to the sunset review schedule, in a law governing the Indian Affairs Council.
- 2**      **Citizens advisory council.** Strikes a reference to the sunset review schedule, in a law governing the Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Advisory Council.
- 3**      **State traumatic brain injury program.** Strikes a reference to the sunset review schedule, in a law governing an advisory committee on program and service needs of persons with brain injuries.
- 4**      **Expiration.** Strikes a reference to the sunset review schedule, in a law governing the American Indian Child Welfare Advisory Council.
- 5**      **Council on Black Minnesotans.** Strikes a reference to the Sunset Advisory Commission, and instead refers to the governor and legislature, in a law requiring reporting by the Council on Black Minnesotans.
- 6**      **Revisor's instruction.** Instructs the Revisor to delete references to the Sunset Advisory Commission.
- 7**      **Repealer.** Repeals the Minnesota Sunset Act in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 3D. Repeals a

2012 session law requesting the Legislative Auditor to conduct a review of the sunset process in 2018.

**8**      **Effective date.** Sections 1 to 7 are effective the day following final enactment.
