Overview

This bill creates the early dental prevention initiative, which requires the commissioner of health to develop a statewide initiative to increase awareness in communities of color and recent immigrants on the importance of early dental care. The bill also creates a grant program to be administered by the commissioner to dentists and nonprofit dental clinics for adding a dental operatory and necessary dental equipment.

Section

- 1 Early dental prevention initiative.** Adds § 144.3875. (a) Requires the commissioner of health to collaborate with the commissioner of human services to implement a statewide initiative to increase awareness in certain communities on the importance of early preventive dental intervention for infants and toddlers.
 - (b) Requires the commissioner to develop certain educational materials and information for expectant and new parents on the importance of early dental care.
 - (c) Requires the commissioner to develop a distribution plan to ensure materials are distributed.
 - (d) Requires the commissioner to work with certain groups in developing the materials.
 - (e) Requires the commissioner to develop and pilot incentives to encourage early dental care for infants.
- 2 Grants for dental operatory expansion.** Requires the commissioner to award grants to private practicing dentists or nonprofit dental clinics for adding a dental operatory and necessary dental equipment. Provides for requirements for eligibility for the grant and

requires the commissioner to award grants until funds are expended. Limits awards to no more than 33 percent of the total cost for a specific project expansion and describes application requirements and review procedures.

3 **Appropriation; early dental prevention; dental chair expansion.** (a) Appropriates an unspecified amount of money to the commissioner of health for the biennium ending June 30, 2017, from the general fund for the early dental prevention initiative.

(b) Appropriates \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2016 to the commissioner of health from the general fund for dental chair expansion grants.
