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## Overview

This section clarifies when and how the notice of architectural barrier is required and when civil actions can be filed after a notice has been sent.

### Section

- 1** **Notice of architectural barrier.** Clarifies when a notice of architectural barrier must be provided and when a civil action can be filed against a person or business who has failed to remedy the violation of accessibility if they are required to do so.  
**Effective date.** This section applies to civil actions brought under the Human Rights Act on or after the day after final enactment.
- 2** **Exemptions.** Provides an exemption for attorneys representing the state or a political subdivision, or actions for claims resulting from a physical injury or brought through the Human Rights Department's administrative process.  
**Effective date.** This section applies to Human Rights Act cases brought on or after the day after final enactment.
