This bill prohibits a consumer reporting agency from charging a fee to a consumer for placing, temporarily lifting, or removing a security freeze. It also requires arbitration or mediation to occur where the consumer lives. This bill also requires that after a data breach the consumer reporting agency must offer credit monitoring services for free for six years. These sections are effective the day following final enactment.
