## Overview

A school district's general education revenue is provided primarily through state aid; however a few of the general education components have an equalized levy as well. As a result, the statutory general education aid appropriation consists of a basic amount and then lists additional aid for each of the general education components that have a separate equalized aid and levy. The appropriation for the various general education aid components is called an open and standing appropriation. "Open" because it automatically adjusts for changes in pupil counts and other underlying data, and "standing" because it is an annual statutory appropriation that needs no periodic legislative reauthorization.

H.F. 2401 eliminates an obsolete reference to the student achievement levy (which has been repealed), and corrects an incorrect cross-reference.
