Radon testing in school districts is currently voluntary. This bill requires radon testing in school district buildings, and makes the test results public data.

1	<p><b>Radon testing.</b></p> <p><b>Subd. 1. Plan.</b> Requires the commissioners of health and education to develop a plan to require school districts to test for radon. Testing requirements apply to the Minnesota State Academies and the Perpich Center for Arts Education.</p> <p><b>Subd. 2. Radon testing.</b> Requires a school district to include radon testing as part of its ten-year facility plan. Requires all districts to conduct the test according to the testing plan developed by the commissioners of health and education.</p> <p><b>Subd. 3. Reporting.</b> Requires a school district to report its results to the Department of Education. Classifies radon testing results as public data.</p>
