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Overview

This bill requires school districts to include substance misuse prevention instruction into the health curriculum for certain grades, and encourages districts, charter schools, and tribal contract schools to integrate substance misuse prevention instruction into existing curriculum and programs.

Section	Description
1	Required academic standards. Requires school districts to include substance misuse prevention instruction in a health curriculum in grades 5, 6 or 7, 8, 9 or 10, and 12.
2	Substance misuse prevention. Encourages school districts, charter schools, and tribal contract schools to integrate substance misuse prevention instruction into existing programs, curriculum, or school environment. Requires the commissioner of education to provide schools with information and assistance.
3	Appropriation. Appropriates funding for the For Jake's Sake Foundation to integrate substance misuse prevention instruction into school district programs and curricula.
