Overview

This bill requires sheriffs to: (1) preserve and protect the constitutional rights and health and welfare of inmates in county jails; and (2) apply jail rules equally to all inmates regardless of which government entity ordered detention.

| 1 | Inmate constitutional rights.
Requires the commissioner of corrections and sheriffs to preserve and protect the constitutional rights and health and welfare of inmates in state prisons and county jails. |
| 2 | Equal treatment.
Requires sheriffs to apply jail rules equally to inmates regardless of which government entity ordered detention. Mandates that sheriffs may not renew contracts that provide for treatment of inmates that violates this section. |
| 3 | Effective date.
Establishes May 1, 2021, as the effective date for sections 1 and 2. |
