

Subject Vehicle registration kiosks

Overview

This bill directs the Department of Public Safety to undertake a pilot program for self-service kiosks where motor vehicle owners can renew vehicle registration and obtain validation stickers (i.e., tabs), and appropriates an amount to be determined for the program. It is effective the day following enactment.

| 1 | Motor vehicle registration self-service kiosk pilot program.
Directs the Department of Public Safety to undertake a self-service kiosk pilot program for motor vehicle registration renewals. Specifies pilot program requirements, including authority to use a vendor, administration by deputy registrars, and a legislative report due in 2023. Sets a filing fee that matches the current filing amount and allows for a convenience fee that can be retained by a kiosk vendor. Makes the pilot program expire June 30, 2024. |
| 2 | Appropriation.
Appropriates an amount to be specified from the General Fund to the Department of Public Safety for the pilot program. This is a onetime appropriation. |
