Overview

H.F. 709 appropriates \$250,000 each year, beginning in fiscal year 2022, for a grant to the Minnesota Council on Economic Education. Requires the council to:

- (1) provide professional development to Minnesota's teachers implementing state graduation standards in learning areas related to economic education;
- (2) support economic and personal finance programs that teachers supervise and coach; and
- (3) provide support to higher education-based centers for economic education, including those based at Minnesota State University Mankato, Minnesota State University Moorhead, St. Cloud State University, St. Catherine University, and the University of St. Thomas, to support activities in clauses (1) and (2).

Requires the council to report, by February 15 of each year following the receipt of a grant, to the commissioner of education on the number and type of teacher professional development opportunities provided by the council and the affiliated state centers for economic education.
