

Subject Higher education: addiction medicine fellowship

Summary

This bill makes a onetime appropriation of \$240,000 in FY2022 to the Hennepin County Medical Center (HCMC) to provide financial support for up to four physicians enrolled in an addiction medicine fellowship program.

There is no base for this appropriation. However, in FY2017 and FY2018, the Office of Higher Education received an appropriation of \$210,000 per year to support up to four physicians in an addiction medicine fellowship.¹
