Overview

School districts offer a variety of career pathways for students. The Houston school district operates the Minnesota Virtual Academy which offers online courses for students throughout the state and operates a high school career pathways program called Stride. Stride offers four different career pathways, Business, Health and Human Services, Information Technology, and Manufacturing and Trades.

H.F. 1337, as amended, provides a grant of \$100,000 to the Minnesota Virtual Academy to strengthen the Manufacturing and Trades career pathway for the program operated in conjunction with Operating Engineers Local 49 and to encourage additional student participation in the program.
