

Subject Peer mentoring program for licensed family child care providers

Summary

This bill appropriates \$50,000 in the 2022-23 biennium to the Department of Human Services (DHS) for a grant to the Minnesota Child Care Provider Information Network (MCCPIN) to establish a peer mentoring program for licensed family child care providers. MCCPIN must use the grant money to revise and update peer mentoring program curricula, recruit and train mentors and program participants, and support mentors and active mentoring. MCCPIN must submit an initial report on the program to the legislature by September 1, 2022, and a final report by June 30, 2023.
