Summary

Under current law, cities and towns may impose a local lodging tax of up to three percent without legislative approval, provided that 95 percent of the proceeds are used to promote tourism.

H.F. 1676 would allow the city of Woodbury to impose an additional local lodging tax of up to three percent and dedicate two-thirds of the proceeds to capital improvements to public recreational facilities.
