

Subject Prescription Drug Co-payment Limits

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Overview

This bill limits health plan co-payments to \$25 per one-month supply for drugs prescribed to treat a chronic disease and related medical supplies.

1	<p>Co-payments for prescription drugs to treat chronic disease. Adds § 62Q.481.</p> <p>Subd. 1. Co-payment limit. Requires a health plan that imposes prescription drug co-payments to limit co-payments to \$25 per one-month supply for prescription drugs prescribed to treat a chronic disease and related medical supplies necessary to administer the drugs.</p> <p>Subd. 2. Definition of chronic disease. Defines this term as diabetes, asthma, and allergies requiring the use of epinephrine auto-injectors.</p> <p>States that the section is effective January 1, 2022, and applies to health plans offered, issued, and renewed on or after that date.</p>
