## Overview

This bill requires health plans, Medical Assistance, and MinnesotaCare to cover the treatment of ectodermal dysplasias, including reconstructive breast surgery, hair prostheses, and dental services.

1	<p><b>Required coverage.</b></p> <p>Requires health plans to include coverage for reconstructive breast surgery due to ectodermal dysplasia.</p> <p><b>Effective date.</b> This section is effective January 1, 2023.</p>
2	<p><b>Required coverage.</b></p> <p>Requires health plans to include coverage for hair prostheses due to hair loss from ectodermal dysplasias.</p> <p><b>Effective date.</b> This section is effective January 1, 2023.</p>
3	<p><b>[62A.3096] Coverage for ectodermal dysplasias.</b></p> <p><b>Subd. 1. Definition.</b> Defines ectodermal dysplasias.</p> <p><b>Subd. 2. Coverage.</b> Requires health plans to include coverage for the treatment of ectodermal dysplasias.</p> <p><b>Subd. 3. Dental coverage.</b> (a) Requires health plans to include coverage for dental treatments related to ectodermal dysplasias, including bone grafts, dental implants, orthodontia, dental prosthodontics, and dental maintenance.</p> <p>(b) Clarifies that if a dental treatment is covered under a dental plan the coverage under paragraph (a) is secondary.</p>

	<b>Effective date.</b> This section is effective January 1, 2023.
4	<b>Ectodermal dysplasias.</b> Requires Medical assistance and MinnesotaCare to cover treatment for ectodermal dysplasias, including the coverages described in sections 1 to 3.  <b>Effective date.</b> This section is effective January 1, 2023.
