Overview

Under current law, law enforcement agencies are not permitted to turn over criminal history data when performing a background check related to employment with a city or county or licensing by a city or county. The law enforcement agency must review the criminal history and inform the city or county as to whether a person's criminal history includes a disqualifying offense. This bill permits the law enforcement agencies to release the criminal history data.
