


Student Enrollment Data

July 2023


This document shows student enrollment in Minnesota K-12 schools from 1960 to 2029 in graphic and tabular forms.

Student counts are based on average daily membership (ADM) for school districts and charter schools and includes school district student counts, private contract students, and high school students attending college under the PSEO program. The student count for nonpublic schools and home schools is based on the fall enrollment count of students. Data is final through fiscal year 2022, based on the February 2023 Forecast estimate for fiscal years 2023 through 2027, and informally estimated for fiscal years 2028 and 2029.
